

OVERSEAS NURSES

IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

Nurse's full name

Address in Australia

Details of previous visits

Sponsorship is available for Registered Nurses Div. 1 and Div. 2 who successfully meet the criteria of the Immigration Department.

Passport and visa details – certified copies

Nurses Board of Victoria Registration Certificate or Receipt

Any dependants (including spouse, children/custody)

Marriage Certificate of applicant and spouse or any change of name

Date of birth and copy of birth certificate – certified copy

Police record check from country you have resided in for a period of 12 months in the last 10 years

Police clearance certificate

Resume

Copies of degrees, diplomas etc.

Private Health Insurance – pay for one month and obtain a receipt (for nurse and any dependants)

Health check: "Form 160A" - Radiologist report on chest x-ray of an applicant for an Australian visa – with passport size photo attached.

Complete Immigration Forms: 1066, 1068, 1190 with passport photo

Sign copy of standard Sponsorship Agreement with Malvern Nurses Agency

All overseas nurses **MUST** be proficient with English and have qualifications that satisfy the Nurses Board of Victoria.

All documents **MUST** be in English – translated documents need to be legally approved.

When we have approved your sponsorship you should apply to your Australian High Commission or Australian Embassy.
